

CSVFD Rules & Regulations for the **Sportsmen's Spring Bash** Saturday, March 9th, 2024

- Ticket donation is \$50.00 each
- 1,000 tickets available for this raffle
- All proceeds benefit the Castle Shannon Volunteer Fire Department (CSVFD)
- Doors open at 11:30 AM (if physical bash is held)
- You must have an official ticket and photo I.D. to enter the event. Only one person will be admitted per ticket
- No one under the age of 21 will be admitted or allowed to purchase tickets
- Only ONE name is allowed to be filled out on each raffle ticket (PLEASE use a proper first and last name, no nicknames)
- Winning number for each prize listed on the ticket will be determined by CSVFD ball machine drawing
- If a physical bash cannot be held, a live video drawing of the ticket prizes will be held via Facebook
- No cash options available - If a background check is denied a gift card will be substituted at the cash value set by the CSVFD
- CSVFD reserves the right to substitute prizes for equal or greater value as deemed necessary due to stocking issues
- Free food and beverages from noon to 4:00PM (if physical bash is held) NO outside alcohol is permitted into the event!
- Winner need not be present to win prizes on the entry ticket – If a physical bash cannot be held, winners will be notified on how to obtain their prize certificate/s. Certificate/s MUST be presented at Allegheny Arms to claim ALL ticket prizes!
- Proper identification is required for the prize/s to be awarded
- All gun tax and insta-checks are paid for by the CSVFD
- Income tax on all prizes is the responsibility of the winner
- You can win more than once
- All entry ticket prizes must be claimed within 60 days of the event date, or will be forfeited
- All winners of prizes on the entry ticket not present at the event will need to refer to the winning numbers posted on the website: www.csvfd.org and contact the office for instructions by calling 412-884-7913
- Additional Raffles and drawings will be available throughout the day of the event at an additional cost
- All winning prizes for “walk-a-round tickets” and “pick of the table tickets” MUST be claimed by the end of the event. NO exceptions!
- Drinking and driving are against the law. Taxi service information will be available
- CSVFD is not responsible for typographical errors
- A fee of \$45.00 will be charged for all NSF checks
- All decisions of the CSVFD are deemed final
- Seating is limited / first come, first served
- NO FIREARMS or WEAPONS of any sort permitted on the property of the CSVFD (unless pre-authorized by the committee)
